

Mayoral Minute

On Tuesday 9th November, **Australia Pacific LNG** received approval for the third LNG project on Curtis Island. Construction of the project, including the first of two LNG trains could commence in 2011, with first exports scheduled for 2014.

There are a number of conditions, including:

- transport plans to ensure councils are not burdened with infrastructure costs;
- workers to be housed in temporary quarters on Curtis island;
- gas pipes to be located underground;
- infrastructure corridors to be used; and
- provision of housing for 50% of the operational workforce.

Federal Government approval is still needed for the project.

Once again, I will state – this is a time for the three levels of Government - Local, State and Federal to work together – with these companies - to achieve the required infrastructure for our community.
